



HOW TO INSPECT A 3-PRONG EXTENSION CORD

Always check an extension cord before using it to make sure it is safe and in proper working condition.



STEP ONE: Start by unplugging the cord to remove any risk of electrical shock during the inspection.



STEP TWO: Examine the full length of the cord for cuts, cracks, fraying, or other visible damage.

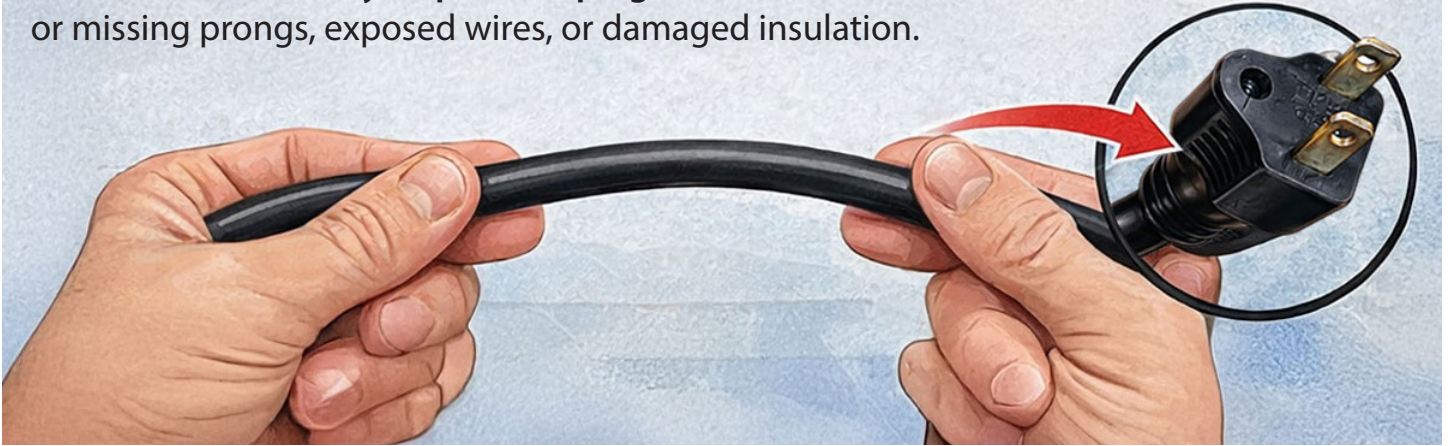




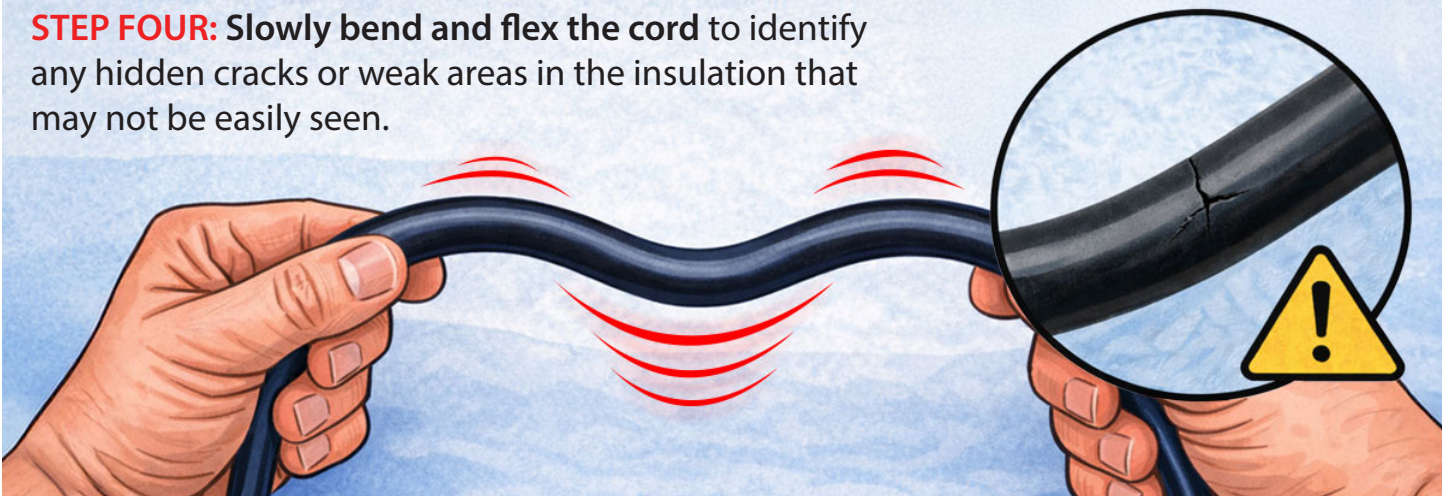

STEP THREE: Carefully inspect the plug and connectors for bent or missing prongs, exposed wires, or damaged insulation.



STEP FOUR: Slowly bend and flex the cord to identify any hidden cracks or weak areas in the insulation that may not be easily seen.



STEP FIVE: If any damage is found, immediately remove the cord from service.

Report it to your supervisor and ensure it is properly discarded and replaced.
